With the starting of our term, we initiated with our first college level event, the **Sprinters-2024**. The event is exclusively designed and curated for first year students to upgrade their knowledge with corporate soft-skills. For this year, on the first day we organized a lecture series from third year students on the topics **Effective Communication**, **Networking and Socializing** and **Technical Skills**. On the second day we organized a fun activity of **Treasure Hunt** within the college after which a lecture is conducted on the **Four Years of Engineering**. **Also**, a guest lecture of **Mr**. **Dhruv Mohite (VW Factory Racer, Young Entrepreneur)** was organized. With **251 active and happy participants** the event was a grand success.

After the grand success we continued with the organisation of the International Student Conference ABHIGYAN 2024. This conference provides a platform for students to interact with various dignitaries from diverse field. For this year we invited Mr. Kshitij Patwardhan (Indian screenwriter, director, playwright and lyricist), Mr. Koushik Marathe (Cotton-King), Mr. Rajendra Singh (Conservationist, Environmentalist), Adv. Ujjwal Nikam (Indian special public prosecutor), Abhijeet Kandakekar (TV Actor). With the presence of nearly 800 students and professionals, the event took place successfully at the Hotel Sayaji, Victoria Banquet Hall, Kolhapur on December 1st, 2024. With the strong support of the college management and our sponsors the event got a huge success.

With this we continued to our next event the Flyers 2025. The event was prior designed especially for second year students. But this year tried doing something new, we opened this event for the students of all the academic years. Where we implemented a lecture series for developing awareness among the students regarding Masters and

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abroad study on the first day. For the activity we called upon the professionals from **Eduallinace-Study Abroad Consultancy.** With this the topics like **Resume Building**, **Corporate etiquettes, corporate social responsibility** were covered in further lecture series. For a fun activity on second day, we simulated an interview process to get the students an idea about how the actual interview process works. Also, a guest session was conducted by Mr. Anil H. Shinde (Director of Kolhapur Airport, Airport Authority of India) who guided students about the future routes and different paths to choose as an Engineer. For the event we had **159 participants**. SPRINTERS 2024

Sprinters is a series of soft skill and personality development sessions specially designed and curated for First Year students. Guiding students to improve their personality and soft skill has always been the core motive of Sprinters.

Sprinters is a lecture series along with personality development activities for first year students to enhance soft skills. We introduce topics like Presentation skills, Interview skills, Resume building, etc. We also conduct activities through which students learn to develop confidence, presentation skill, communication skill and networking.

From 2019-20 we have also started introducing technical workshops for first year students. These workshops cover topics like graphics designing using Corel draw, Python, web designing, etc. We also conduct competition based on the workshops. We conduct these workshops to boost engagement and enthusiasm of the students in these workshops.

The main motive for introducing technical session along with soft skill session is to make students equally strong with technical knowledge and give them a sneak-peek with latest technology trends in engineering.





DAY 1 – SPARK THE VISION

The first day of the "Sprinters" event, themed "Spark the Vision," set the stage for an enriching and inspiring experience for all participants. The day was meticulously crafted to balance informative sessions, interactive activities, and skill-building exercises, creating an ideal mix of learning and engagement.

The event kicked off with a opening ceremony, led by the respected Director of the College. Throughout the day, the dedicated core team of WWW facilitated the sessions, ensuring a smooth and impactful experience for all attendees. This ceremony marked the start of an exciting journey, instilling a sense of purpose and enthusiasm for the sessions to come.

The day's first session, titled "Effective Communication," highlighted the vital role of communication skills in both academic and professional environments. The session delved into the significance of communication, covering various types such as verbal, non-verbal, and written forms, along with strategies to overcome communication barriers. To enhance engagement, participants took part in interactive games and activities aimed at reinforcing the concepts discussed, promoting collaboration and practical application of the skills learned.

The second session, titled "Networking and Socializing," focused on the significance of establishing connections during the early stages of an engineering career. It explored the reasons why networking is essential for first-year students, clarified the distinctions between networking and socializing, and emphasized their distinct roles in both personal and professional growth. Participants were introduced to LinkedIn, an essential platform for professional networking, and received guidance on how to create and optimize their LinkedIn profiles, laying the groundwork for their online presence. The session wrapped up with games and activities designed to improve networking and socializing skills.

The final session of the day, called "Technical Skills," was designed specifically for firstyear engineering students, many of whom are just starting their journey into the technical field. This session offered a basic understanding of essential technical skills, suggestions for foundational courses in various departments, and an introduction to online platforms such as Coursera, Udemy, and LinkedIn Learning to help them master these skills. The goal was to provide participants with the knowledge and resources they need to effectively begin their technical journey.

Day 1 of "Sprinters" was a huge success, leaving participants feeling motivated and wellinformed. The mix of sessions, interactive games, and practical takeaways made sure everyone walked away with a sense of accomplishment and enthusiasm for the next day.

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DAY 2 – SPRINT TO DISCOVER

The second and final day of "Sprinters 2024," themed "Sprint to Discover," was the most dynamic and eventful day of the event, leaving a lasting impression on all participants. The day was thoughtfully organized to strike a perfect balance between activities, sessions, and inspiring talks, making it a well-rounded and unforgettable experience.

Additionally, he praised the field of engineering as one that promotes problem-solving and innovation, stressing the importance of building trust as a foundation for both personal and professional success.

2. United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC)




Agenda: Addressing Human Rights Violations in War Zones: A Historical Analysis of the Indian Subcontinent and Current Global Conflict Situations

Day 1 – Inauguration and Commencement of Committees: 12th April 2025

Registrations started at 3:00 PM:
